

ANGRÆCUM *Fasciola*; aphyllum, acaule, radicibus longissimis flexuosis, spicis erectis multifloris distichis distantibus, sepalis petalisque linearibus acutis, labello membranaceo petalis adnato! apice brevi triangulari, calcare pendulo obtuso inflato lævi.—A small leafless plant, with the habit of *A. tenue*, only the flowers are much larger, although very small, and distinctly distichous. It answers to the short character we possess of *Limodorum Fasciola*, a plant I have never seen; but as the latter is a native of the Society Islands it is probably distinct.—
