

22. *Oreophilus nummularius* (Rchb.f.) Archila comb. nov.

Basionym. *Lepanthes nummularia* Rchb.f., Xenia Orchid. 1: 142, 1858.

Synonym. *Brachycladium nummularium* (Rchb.f.) Luer.

Etymology. From the Latin *numularis* like small coins, alluding to appearance of the habit.
