## Platystele compacta, comb. nov.

Stelis compacta Ames Orch. 3 (1908) 76, t. 53. The genus Platystele is at present confined to Central America and as now limited contains only two species, P. bulbinella Schltr. from Costa Rica and the present species which was described originally from material collected in Guatemala by H. von Tuerckheim. These species are very closely related, P. bulbinella being a much stouter plant than P. compacta, with longer leaves and a more robust raceme, but with very similar flowers. An examination of more material than I have seen may prove that the Costa Rican species is simply a larger form of P. compacta.
