PLEUROTHALLIS *gēlīdā*; folio oblongo carnosio concavo basi attenuato caule tereti laxè 1-ochreato æquali v. longiore, spicis geminis erectis secundis folio subæqualibus e spathâ brevi univalvi exsertis, floribus cylindraceutis, sepalis carnosiss intus pilosis lateralibus semiconnatis, petalis minimis glabris subrotundo-oblongis apice denticulatis, labello etiam breviorè lineari cuneato bilamellato apice rotundato plano, columnâ petalis breviorè.

A plant with all the habit of *Pl. racemiflora*, but the spikes appear in pairs, and are hardly so long as the leaf, and the structure of the flowers is different. The whole plant is fully a foot high. Messrs. Loddiges obtained it from Jamaica.
